

Cork Diva Wallet

Supply List:

One 18" x 17" piece of cork or 1 large roll from The Old Country Store (a large roll makes 2 wallets)

For contrast pockets – 1 small roll of cork

Complementary quilting cotton 17" x 8"

1 - 9" or longer zipper in a fun contrasting color

Pellon Décor Bond – ¼ yd (or one piece cut 8" x 9")

1 – 7 ½" metal Diva Wallet frame

Schmetz 9/14 Microtex Needle

Mettler Metrosene Thread or Mettler Poly Sheen

Pattern – Provided by teacher

Tools:

Sharp scissors

Clips for fabric

Rotary cutter with new blade

Quilting ruler

Small ruler

Seam ripper

Pencil

Dritz 1/4"

basting tape

Zipper foot

¼" foot

Extra small Phillips head screw driver



All tools and materials are available for purchase from The Old Country Store.

Please do not purchase your cork from Amazon as it is a low-grade cork that is not durable.

Cutting instructions: Please come to class with the quilting cotton and Decor Bond prepared. Do not fuse the interfacing. **The cork will be cut in class.** Be sure you have a new blade in your rotary cutter.

Quilting cotton:

Inside wallet body – one 8" x 9" rectangle

Lining for zipper and open pocket - two 8" x 4"

Inside wallet body – one 8" x 9"
