

Pattern: Twisted Peppermint by Cut Loose Press

Fabric Requirements

- ¼ yard red
- ⅓ yard cream
- ¼ yard green
- ¾ yard black (background fabric)
- ¼ yard binding not needed for day of class
- ¾ yard Backing not needed for day of class

Notions

- Creative Grids 18 Degree Dresden Plate by Creative Grid, required
- 6" square ruler
- Batting 21" x 41" (not needed for the day of class)
- ¼ yard or three scraps pieces of 3 ½" SF 101
- Buttons ⅞" white and ½" red 3 of each color, optional and not needed for day of class
- Roxanne's Basting Glue
- Rotary Cutter
- Small Cutting Mat, at least 12" square
- Point Turner
- Seam Ripper
- Erasable Marker
- Pins
- Snips for cutting threads
- Thread for piecing
- Thread for applique to match Candy Cane and Holly. I like using color threads, but if you do not want the thread to show, I suggest Monopoly Clear thread.

Sewing Machine, with cord and foot control in good working condition, or use one of the machines in the classroom.

- 90/14
- ¼ in foot, 37, 57, 97
- Open Toe foot 20C

Prep Work Ahead of Class

Cut the following Fabrics. At the start of class, we will begin cutting the wedges in class.

- Red: Cut (2) 2 ½" x WOF and cut (1) 3 ½" x WOF
- Cream: Cut (2) 2 ½" x WOF and cut (3) 1 ½" strips for your inner boarder
- Green: Cut (1) 8" x WOF
- Black: (Background)
 - Cut (2) 4 ½" x WOF strips sub-cut (3) 4 ½" x 9 ½", (3) 4 ½" x 8 ½", (2) 4 ½" x 2 rectangles
 - Cut (1) 3" x WOF strip, sub-cut (3) 3" x 8 ½" and (1) 3" x 4 ½" rectangles
 - Cut (1) 1 ½" x WOF strip, sub-cut (1) 1 ½" x 8 ½" and (1) 1 ½" x 33"

- Cut (4) $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF , sub-cut 1 strip (3) $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x $6\frac{1}{2}$ " rectangles and save the rest for outer border
