Supply Requirements

	Small 12"W x 8"H	Medium 15"W x 10"H	Large 17"W x 12 1/2"H
Suggested items for each size (always measure item first then compare to finished sizes given)	iPad, tablet, reading books, smaller sized notebooks	Small to medium laptop, paper notebooks, coloring books	Medium to large laptop
Main Fabric*	1/2 yard	1/2 yard	1/2 yard
Lining Fabric*	1/2 yard	2/3 yard	1 yard
Accent Fabric*	1/4 yard	1/3 yard	1/3 yard
Foam Stabilizer or Batting	13" x 25"	16" x 30"	18" x 36"
Fusible Interfacing (optional)	12" x 8"	15" x 12"	17" x 13"
Webbing	23" (1" wide)	28" (1 1/2" wide)	34" (1 1/2" wide)
Hardware (match to width of webbing: 1" or 1 1/2")	(1) Swivel Hook (1) D-Ring or Triangle Ring	(1) Swivel Hook (1) D-Ring or Triangle Ring	(1) Swivel Hook (1) D-Ring or Triangle Ring
Zipper	14" or longer	18" or longer	20" or longer

* Non-directional fabric works best. Directional fabric may require more yardage.

Zipper info: #4.5 or #5 zippers by the yard are perfect for this project.

Basic Sewing Kit

- Thread in neutral shade to match fabric: Aurifil 50 weight works well for machine quilting the body of the pouch, but I prefer a stronger 100% polyester thread for the actual bag construction. Superior So Fine or Mettler polyester threads are good options.
- Strong Pins
- Thread snips
- Seam ripper

Sewing Machine, etc.

- Sewing machine in good working order
- Walking foot with guide bar
- 1/4" piecing foot
- Zipper foot
- Overcast foot or a foot that will allow you to stitch a zig zag stitch
- 90/14 Topstitch needle

Rotary Cutting Supplies

- Rotary cutter
- Acrylic rulers - my favorite sizes:
 - 4" x 14"
 - 6" x 24"
- Cutting mat, 18" x 24" (optional)

Misc Tools & Notions

- Clover Wonder Clips
- Clover Chaco Liner (white only!) or hera marker
- Clover Tailor's Awl or stiletto
- Tube turner
- Clover Clip 'n Glide Bodkin
- Marking pen or pencil
- Utility scissors or designated rotary cutter for trimming zippers
- Roxanne Glue-Baste-It (I love the EZ Squeezie bottle)

Optional Supplies:

- 1/8" basting tape

Additional Notes:

- Please cut your fabrics prior to class using the chart on p. 3 of the pattern. ***If at all possible, cut your main fabric, lining, and Soft & Stable 1" wider than the pattern suggests (small: 14" x 25", Medium: 17" x 30", Large: 19" x 36").
- Feel free to quilt your fabric ahead of time.
- Low loft batting can be used in place of the Soft and Stable foam stabilizer, but I love the structure Soft & Stable provides.
- I like Shape Flex 101 for the interfacing.
