

Stash and Dash Fold-over Organizer Student Supply List

Fabric & Notions (as listed on the back of the pattern): Note - avoid directional prints for best results.

- Stash and Dash Fold-over Organizer Pattern
- Main fabric (body of organizer) – 1 fat quarter
- Lining fabric (lining of organizer) – 1 fat quarter
- Contrasting fabric (bindings and strap) – ½ yard
- ByAnnie's Soft and Stable (stabilizer) – 10" x 20-1/2"
- Mesh fabric – three 5" x 9" pieces
- Clear vinyl, heavyweight (for back pocket) – 7" x 5"
- Zippers: three 10" or longer vinyl zippers, or one 30" double-slide handbag zipper with an extra zipper pull (I prefer dressmaking zippers vs the larger handbag zippers.)
- 1" polypro strapping – 18"
- 1" wide-mouth slider (strap closure)

Basic Sewing Kit

- Thread in neutral shade to match fabric: Aurifil 50 wt or So Fine weight works well. You may want to select thread to match each fabric as we will be machine quilting the body of the organizer as well as topstitching the strap and binding.
- Pins:
 - Flat Flowerhead pins for pinning stabilizer and zippers
 - Quilter's extra-fine pins for pinning fabric
- Fabric shears
- Thread snips
- Seam ripper
- Hand sewing needle
- Thimble, if you like

Sewing Machine, etc.

- Sewing machine in good working order
- Walking foot with guide bar
- 1/4" piecing foot
- Straight stitch foot (if you have) or zipper foot
- Zig zag stitch foot
- Teflon foot (optional - for sewing on vinyl)
- 90/14 Microtex or Topstitch needle

Rotary Cutting Supplies

- Rotary cutter, 45 mm or larger
- Acrylic rulers - my favorite sizes:
 - 4" x 14"

- 6" x 24"
- Cutting mat, 18" x 24"

Misc Tools & Notions

- Clover Wonder Clips
- Clover Chaco Liner (white only!!) or Frixion pen
- Hera marker
- Clover Tailor's Awl or stiletto
- Wooden finger press
- Bodkin or large safety pin
- Roxanne Glue-Baste-it
- 1/4" double-sided basting tape
- Fray Check
- Machine quilting gloves, optional

Please cut out your fabrics ahead of time to ensure plenty of time for stitching during class. To keep track of all the various pieces, cut out the labels on page 3 of the Student Supply List and pin or clip to your fabric pieces as you cut them.

Note: measurements are listed as length (lengthwise grain) of fabric x width (crosswise grain of fabric).

- From main fabric cut:
 - body of organizer - 10" x 20"
 - zipper pulls - three 1" x 12" pieces
- From lining fabric cut:
 - lining of organizer - 10" x 20"
- From contrasting fabric cut **(be sure to follow PDF cutting layout provided with class materials instead of pattern):**
 - strap - 2-3/4" x 19"
 - bias binding - three strips 2-1/4" x bias width of fabric
 - bindings for zippered mesh pockets - six 2" x 9"
 - bindings for vinyl pocket - one 2" x 5" and two 1-1/4" x 8"
