

## **Mini Barn Quilt Supply List**

Looking forward to walking you through how to paint your very own Mini Barn Quilt! You will be provided with a primed 11" square MDF board (primed on front and sides). **Please be prepared to pay me \$8.00 per board (cash, check, or Venmo) the day of class.**

Please bring the additional supplies listed below:

### **Supplies:**

- 12" office supply ruler, or Ofla makes a 1-1/4" x 12" ruler that is perfect for this project.
- 1" x 6" acrylic ruler
- Pencil
- Foam painting brushes, at least one for each color of paint. 1" and 2" sizes work well, OR you may use bristle brushes, but you'll need to plan on wrapping them in plastic and washing them out at home. Mini foam rollers are another option for painting your background paint.
- Green FrogTape - this is key; blue painters tape in place of the green FrogTape does not give good results. The narrower 1" width is sufficient.
- Paint (see additional info below)\*
  - background color
  - accent color
- Paper towels or rags
- Hair dryer
- Disposable latex gloves (if you are a messy painter like me!)
- Paint apron or smock
- Small paper plates (if using craft paints)

Keep in mind that painting can be messy, no matter how careful you are, so please dress appropriately. :)

### **\* Note re: paint options:**

These Mini Barn Quilts are designed for indoor display. Since these will be for indoor use, you can choose just about any interior paint you like. Good quality craft paint works well, or if you want a better selection of colors, you can purchase a custom tint at a paint store. I went to my local hardware store and purchased 14 oz. cans of satin-finish sample paint in two different colors; that way I could choose any color I wanted and the sheen matched. Just make sure you use the same type of paint for all colors.

If you would like to display your Mini Barn Quilt outdoors, you would need to also prime the back and select an exterior paint which can withstand the elements and contains UV protectants (Michaels carries exterior paints in small sizes).

I'll be providing you with a variety of two-color Mini Barn Quilt designs to choose from. Feel free to search Instagram, Pinterest, or look at my Mini Barn Quilt Pinterest Board

for more ideas. You'll need to select a design that is made of 16 (4x4), or 25 (5x5) blocks.
