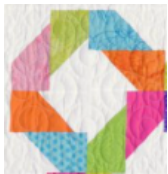
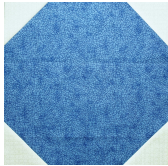

1-1201 Corner Pop - is unlike any other quilting tool and oh so much fun! Pop once or Pop twice! This tool is so versatile and pretty soon you'll be "Popping" the corners off of all your Tucker University units and giving them that "Pop" of pizzazz! For years, these units were created using the "folded corner" technique. The end result was either too big, too small, crooked and way too wasteful. Never struggle with folded corners again!

Basic Sewing Supplies -

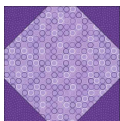
- Sewing Machine with a new needle,
- power cords and manual (just in case)
- Thread - 50 wt is good for piecing
- Snips or trimming scissors
- Seam ripper
- Extra fine Pins

Basic Quilting Supplies:

- Rotary Cutter with a sharp blade
- Marking pen or pencil - (frixon pen or mechanical pencil)
- Small cutting mat
- Straight edge ruler 6"x12"
- Invisigrip or true grips highly recommended for the back of tool
- Studio 180 Design Corner Pop
- Studio 180 Design Tucker Trimmer 1 - not mandatory but bring if you have

Fabric Requirements - for this class we will also be using some units that you made in previous Tucker University Classes.

Precutting Instructions -



1 - 4 1/2" square and 2 - 2 3/4" squares cut once on the diagonal for replacement triangles.



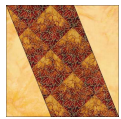
1 - 5 1/2" square and 2 - 3 3/4" squares cut once on the diagonal for replacement triangles.

1 - 4 1/2" x 8 1/2" rectangle and 2 - 2 1/4" squares cut once on the diagonal for replacement triangles.

2 - 2 3/4" squares cut once on the diagonal for replacement triangles for each unit you want to pop. These replacement triangles should read as a solid and be in strong contrast to your Pre - class units as specified below.

Units of your choice that have a cut size of 4 1/2" or in the case of a flying geese the cut size would be 4 1/2" x 2 1/2". For example, you may elect to construct 4 1/2" half square triangles, 4 1/2" combination units or 4 1/2" quarter square triangles (hour glass units), 4 1/2" V Block units or 4 1/2" Corner Beam units, or 4 1/2" Square squared. (You can bring whatever units you would like to pop. You can bring samples of all the above or just one type of unit.

I will also cover how to use Corner Pop 2 and Corner Pop 3 tools in class. You do not have to purchase these tools for class but if you have them already you can bring them to class to try or you can use my tools. I will have some for purchase if you desire.



Corner Pop 2 cutting directions if you would like to try tool.

1 - 5" square focus fabric

1 - 5 1/2" x 10" strip for replacement triangles



Corner Pop 3 cutting directions if you would like to try tool.

1 - 3 3/4" x 7" rectangle focus fabric

1 - 3 3/4" x 7" rectangle background fabric

1 - 2 1/2" x 4" rectangle of contrasting fabric
