French Roses

Supply List

- Pattern "French Roses" by Heather French. (Available at The Old Country Store)
- Sewing Supplies: Rotary Cutter, ruler ,9 1/2" square ruler,(or larger size if you have that) small fabric cutting scissors, craft scissors, 12"x18" sheet of template plastic (not opaque), fine point permanent black marker for tracing pattern pieces onto template plastic, pencil, temporary fabric marker of your choice, neutral or color of choice thread for piecing.
- Fabric for quilt:

Note: In choosing your fabric, keep in mind that this quilt applique is supposed to fray. If you like batiks be aware that they do not fray very much even after washing. In my sample quilts I used one or two but the majority of my fabrics were regular quilting cotton. So if you want the frayed look, you might want to select more of the regular cottons.

- Background Squares and Outer Border: 2 2/3 yards white or very light coordinating fabric
- Flowers, Inner Border, and Binding: 3/4 yard <u>each</u> of 5 coordinating fabrics_ for flowers
- Leaves: 1 fat eighth coordinating tone on tone or solid fabric
- Backing: (not needed for day of class): 4 yds coordinating fabric
