Supply List for Live in Full Bloom

- Sewing supplies: sewing machine, rotary cutter, rulers, neutral thread, craft scissors, fabric scissors, small fabric scissors, seam ripper, pencil, invisible thread like MonoPoly for stitching raw edge applique (optional) OR matching colors of thread for raw edge applique, square ruler 18" or larger (optional)
- A piece of solid or light-colored scrap fabric approximately 8" x8" for practicing raw edge applique. The practice applique pieces will be supplied in class.
- Pattern "Live in Full Bloom" as a download from Quilting Daily

Fabrics, etc...

- 2 7/8 yards of white solid or whatever color you are using for your background
- Assorted bright prints—total of 1 ³/₄ yards
- Assorted green prints ½ yard
- Blue stripe 7/8 yard for blocks and binding
- Backing 3 ¾ yards (not needed for day of class)
- Batting (not needed day of class)
- Fusible web ¾ yard for applique (be sure that it has a paper backing) Suggestions: Heat and Bond feather lite or lite or Steam a Seam lite, or Soft Fuse Premium
- 3 buttons
- Olive embroidery floss

Class Prep

If you are confident in your cutting skills, doing this before class will speed up your progress on the quilt. However, if you need help, bring your fabric to class uncut.

Save the cutting of your applique pieces for class unless you are very experienced in doing this.
