
Vintage Lace Student Supply List

Pattern:

Vintage Lace by Brittany Lloyd of Lo and Behold Stitchery

Fabric Requirements* (as listed on pattern):

FABRIC REQUIREMENTS



Basic Sewing Kit:

- Fabric Shears
- Patchwork pins
- Thread snips
- Seam ripper
- Machine piecing thread in a neutral color to match your fabrics

Rotary Cutting Supplies:

- Depending on the size quilt you are planning to make, you will need either a Bloc Loc Half Square Triangle Ruler OR a square ruler (I am loving the Quilter's Select Rulers!):
 - o Baby: 2.5" square ruler or larger
 - o Throw: 3.5" square ruler or larger
 - o Bed: 5" square ruler or larger

(I will be demonstrating both rulers. Feel free to wait until the day of class to purchase your ruler after you see my demonstration.)

- Rotary cutter with fresh blade
- Acrylic rulers; I like the following sizes:
 - o 6" x 24"
 - o 4" x 14"
- Cutting mat: 18" x 24" is a good size

Additional Supplies:

- Frixion pen or fine tip marking pencil
- ½" marking ruler:
 - o Creative Grids 15" Seam Guide Tool (my favorite), **OR**
 - o Fons and Porter 1/4" Seam Marker, **OR**
 - o Studio 180 Quilters Magic Wand, **OR**
 - o Omnigrid 4", 6", and 12" Marking Ruler Trio

Optional Supplies:

- Wooly Felted Wonders Pressing Bar and Clapper (the 12" size is sufficient), OR The Strip Stick (Both items will allow you to press seams open more easily.)
- Spray starch, Best Press, Flatter, or your favorite starch alternative
- Tailor's clapper
- Clover Tailor's Awl
- Rotating cutting mat

Sewing Machine, etc.:

- Sewing machine in working order
- ½" patchwork foot, if you have
- Sewing machine needles, size 80/12 sharp or universal

*Note: If you wish to make the Sage Modern Version as pictured on The Old Country Store class website and Lo & Behold's blog/Instagram account, below are the Kona cotton colors needed:

- 1. Pomegranate $-\frac{1}{4}$ yd.
- 2. Camellia $\frac{1}{4}$ yd.
- 3. Melon $-\frac{1}{4}$ yd.
- 4. Primrose $-\frac{1}{2}$ yd.
- 5. Bellini $-\frac{1}{2}$ yd.
- 6. Shell $-\frac{1}{2}$ yd.
- 7. Everglade $-\frac{3}{4}$ yd.
- 8. Sage (background) 4 yds.

The *Modern Version* shown on the pattern uses Bordeaux, Valentine, Camellia, Dusty Peach, Grellow, Leather, Yarrow, and Snow.

The Traditional Version uses Snow and Doeskin.

Please cut your fabrics prior to class so that we can get right to sewing all those half square triangles!
