

## Supply List for Jeweled Forest

- Pattern “Jeweled Forest” by McCalls Quilting--available only as a pdf download at <https://www.quiltingdaily.com/product/jeweled-forest-quilt-pattern-download/>  
Cost \$7.99
- Fabric for your project as detailed in the pattern.
- Copies of the foundation piecing templates as requested in pattern. Don't worry about copying them all because you will not finish the project in one day. You will, however, make a good start.  
NOTE: I usually recommend using **Carol Doak's Foundation Papers** or newsprint sheets for copies and these are fine. However, as I finished up my project, I realized how much paper ripping is necessary after you've finished stitching. Therefore, you may want to consider using **Perfect Piecing Foundation Sheets** by June Tailor. They are a bit more expensive but if you find paper-tearing tedious, these might make the job easier. Both can be found at **The Old Country Store**.
- Rotary cutter with small rotary mat for next to your machine
- Sewing machine with needles and a neutral thread
- Thread snips or small scissors
- Glue stick or flat head pin
- Scotch tape (optional)
- Paper-cutting scissors
- Small wooden seam presser, available at **The Old Country Store** (optional)
- Add-a- Quarter ruler

If you want to get a faster start, you can cut out some of your fabrics and organize them according to the block. The dimensions for your pieces are included on the templates in the pattern.
