

Supply List

- 2 fat quarters--one dark, one light or medium in colors of your choice for the churn dash block
- Fabric for backing--approximately 15" x 15"
- Batting piece about 15" x 15" (The Old Country Store has Batting Bits (which are remnants and are well-suited for a small project)
- ¼ yard of fabric for binding. (often a contrasting color looks good or you can use one of the fabrics from your block)
- Rotary cutter with blade (45mm or what you have)
- 6" x 24" ruler or 6" X 12"
- Pins
- Safety pins-- 12-14
- Sewing machine
- Patchwork/1/4 " foot
- Thread for piecing in a neutral color (aurifil is a good choice)
- Seam ripper
- Sewing machine needle-- microtex or jeans 70/10 or 75/11(or what you have)
- Hand sewing needle
- Thread for quilting--can be the same as you used for piecing. Gray is often a good color choice for quilting.
