

## **Travel Outbound Bag:**

Pattern: You will need to purchase the pattern: **Travel Outbound Bag by Inchmark on Etsy**

Fabric and Interfacing as per recommended in the pattern:

- Exterior fabric per the pattern requirements
  - This pattern is great opportunity to add your own style to this bag. Bring scraps, ribbon scraps, fun selvages, tiny orphan blocks and some extra fabric to add your own style to your bag.
- Lining Fabric per the pattern requirements
- Coordinating Polyester Thread
  - There is topstitching on the webbing as well as the exterior and interior of the bag. You may want more than one color of coordinating thread for this project.
- Fusible Woven Interfacing (Pellon SF101) (I recommend a yard which is more than the pattern)
- (Optional) Pellon Fusible Fleece if you want to add any quilted block options to the pockets.
- (Optional) 1/4yd of cotton linen canvas to use as an interlining sandwiched between the exterior layers to add extra structure to the bag.

Hardware as per recommended in the pattern:

- 10" Zippers per recommended in the pattern.
  - I like to use a Nylon Zipper By the Yard to create your own length of zipper tape (which I can show you in class how to do). I recommend Sallie Tomato Brand #5 size,(available at The Old Country Store) but #3 size works well.
- 2 medium capped rivets and rivet setting tool (I will bring my rivet press to class to use if you need to use it)

Tools and Notions:

- Cutting Mat (I like to use 18x24)
- Rotary cutter
- Long Ruler (I like to use 6 x 24)
- Small square ruler (I like to use 4.5" square)
- Pins
- Clips
- Seam Ripper
- Fabric scissors
- A small pair of sharp scissors with a point
- Bias tape maker ¾" width (optional)
- Fabric glue stick
- Roxanne's Glue
- Stiletto Tool
- Tailors Chalk (if using dark fabrics)
- Disappearing ink pen for marking on fabric
- Dritz Fray Check
- Washaway Wonder Tape or By Annies Double Sided Basting Tape
- Hand sewing needle, thimble, and thread if you choose to hand sew your binding on.

Sewing Machine:

- Sewing machine in good working order
- Regular sewing foot attachment for the sewing machine
- Zipper foot attachment for the sewing machine
- Size 90/14 sewing machine needle
- Walking foot for your machine is helpful but not required

**Before Class:**

**Please have your materials gathered and your paper templates cut and taped together. Please ensure that you are printing the pattern 100% for the templates to be the correct size. You can test your template size with the 1" test square on the pages.**
