All Squared Up

Supplies List:

Basic Sewing Kit: Thread to match your fabric Pins Scissors/Thread snips Seam ripper New needle (90/14 recommended) Iron and pressing mat for your station Sewing Machine 1/4" patchwork foot Open toe foot (recommended) Wonder clips (optional)

Additional Supplies: 6" Economy Foundation Paper Piece Pattern Booklet Add A Quarter ruler **Both of the above items are available at The Old Country Store**

Rotary Cutting Supplies: Rotary cutter Rotary mat 12" square or larger for your station Acrylic rulers needed: 8" - 12" long 18"- 24" long (recommended as well)

Fabric Requirements:

You will need a variety of 10" squares.

You will also need fabric for your sashing, center corner posts, borders and binding. All are listed below.

For the best contrast between your blocks and the sashing consider the following:

- If you are using a light fabric for your sashing, choose dark and medium 10" prints for contrast.
- If you are using a dark sashing, a mixture of dark, medium and light 10" prints will work well (see gallery photos)

NOTE:

To determine how many 10" squares you will need for your quilt, keep in mind it takes ONE 10" square to complete ONE 6" Square in a Square block.

Each 10" square will be rotary cut into different shape and sized pieces and then will be mixed and matched with pieces from the additional 10" squares to complete the blocks.

Decide how how many Square in a Square blocks you would like to make, which will determine the number of 10" squares needed, as well as determine the size of your quilt.

For instance, there are 49 completed blocks in the quilt shown, so 49 individual 10" squares were needed. Quilt measures 64" X 64" using a variety of Lori Holt fabric.

Fabrics needed for a quilt finishing at 64" X 64" square:

- Variety of 10" squares (49 total to complete 49 blocks)
- 1 1/2 yards for the sashing (sashing finishes at 2" wide)
- 3/8 yard for the center corner post squares
- 1 1/8" yards for the border (borders finish at 4" wide)
- 1/2" yard for binding
