- Please note you will only be stitching out 1 of the 5 flowers in class as we will not have enough time to stitch out all 5. If you finish early you may have time to stitch out more.

Fabric

- Fabric needed: Please see flower picture for guidance
 - You will need 12" x 12" piece for fabric for each picture embroidered
 - Fabric for your 1st backing 12" x 12" for each picture
 - Piece of felt or batting 7 $1/2^{"}$ x 7 $1/2^{"}$ for each picture
 - Fabric for your 2nd backing 12" x 12" for each picture

Stabilizer

- Light Tear away I used OESD I recommend bring your roll
- Medium Tear away I used OESD I recommend bring your roll
- Hydro Stick I used OESD I recommend bring your roll

Thread

- Bring a variety of threads including all the colors needed for the completion of your flower. Refer to the flower design color chart for suggested colors. But please use your own creative flow when choosing your colors.
- You will need to bring a thick thread for sewing the back of the picture. I recommend Heavy Duty Polyester Top Stitching 30M Nu White You can find this at the Old Country Store

• Seraline – please have bobbin thread prewound Bobbin Case:

- If you have a yellow bobbin case it is highly recommended that you bring this to class.
- If not, you can use a black bobbin case

Needles: -

• Microtex 80/12

Spray Adhesive: 505 preferred

Embroidery Machine: - bring your machine, module, cords foot control, etc.

• Feet: - #26 (embroidery foot)

Hoop: - Large Hoop – If you use this hoop you will have to hoop several times Stitch plate: Single hole 0mm (if you have it) or regular 9mm
