

# PINEAPPLE BLOSSOM QUILT

## Supply List

### Basic Sewing Supplies:

#### \* Sewing Machine

- New needle
- Neutral thread to match your fabric
- Please bring a spool of RED thread
- Scissors/Thread snips
- Fabric glue pen (such as Sewline)
- Iron and pressing mat
- Open toe foot (optional, but helpful to see lines on the paper piece pattern)

### Rotary Cutting Supplies:

- Rotary cutter with new blade - 45mm works best for paper piecing
- Cutting mat - 18" X 24" works well for this project
- Acrylic ruler - 3 1/2" X 12 1/2" (at least 10" long, but 6 X 24 is too large)

### Additional Supplies:

- Add A Quarter ruler
- 5 or more clips - such as Wonder Clips (optional)
- 6 gallon size zip bags

**Please note:** \*\*Paper Piece Pattern will be provided \*\*

### Fabric "Requirements" (to complete the 73" X 73" quilt as shown)

- 22 DARK fat quarters (fat quarters from variety of Kim Diehl collections were used)
- 2 1/2 yards background fabric (for center squares and flying geese)
- Bring at least **12 fat quarters** to class and pre cut as instructed below

### Required Fabric Cutting Instructions Before Class:

- From each fat quarter, cut **12** - 1 1/2" strips length and pin/clip together
- The strips need to be cut lengthwise to measure 1 1/2" X 21" long
- From the background fabric, cut a **3"** strip **AND** a **3 1/4"** strip from your yardage
- Sub cut the 3" strip into 3" squares (yields 13 or 14) and clip together
- Sub cut the 3 1/4" strip into 3 1/4" squares (yields 12) and clip together
