Supply List

Deck the Halls

- Christmas Quilting with Wendy Sheppard (available at The Old Country Store \$9.99)
- Quilt pattern is on page 25 of the book. Fabrics as detailed under the Materials list
- Copies of the foundation templates on page 30 and 31 of the pattern book. You will need 36 copies of pattern A and 36 of pattern B. However, it's not necessary that you make all the copies before the day of class as you will more than likely not get all 36 tree blocks made on class day. Paper suggestions are included below.
- Suggested paper is Carol Doak's Foundation Paper, Perfect Piecing Foundation Sheets, or 8 ½" x 11 newsprint paper. Note that Foundation Pattern A must have an additional piece attached to it before you print all your copies. Suggested that you copy the patterns from the book, cut the pieces out and tape the extra piece to the large Pattern A. Then make your copies of that. Each of the papers listed above can be put through your home printer.
- Your previously cut fabric pieces and extra "just in case" fabric scraps or pieces. When cutting out your fabrics, pay particular attention to Figure 1 on page 27. You'll need to make sure that you have cut the right number of triangles going in the proper direction
- Paper/craft scissors
- Thread for foundation piecing (50 wt. Aurifil) You may also use a lighter weight thread such as 80 or 100 weight for foundation piecing. For traditional piecing, 50 wt. Ariful in a neutral color or any other thread that you like to use for piecing
- Add-a Quarter ruler
- Scotch tape
- Flat head pin or glue stick
- Small rotary mat for next to your machine
- Rotary cutter
