## Supply List

- Pattern: Jelly Stars by Modernly Morgan
- Assorted prints and/or Solids (54) 2 1/2" x 42" WOF strips OR (18) 1/4 yards
- 1 yard fabric for stars (make sure it has high contrast against your fabric strips)
- A few scraps or extra fabric in case you make a mistake or need to practice
- Basic sewing supplies (needles, pins, scissors, thread)
- Marking pen or pencil
- Rotary cutter
- Small cutting mat (optional—we have large mats in the classroom)
- Masking tape, adhesive labels, or other method that you prefer to label your rows. *This is very important*. It should not be something that will fall off the quilt before you have sewn it together.
- Tape measure to cut your strips to the proper length.

NOTE: if you decide to use a jelly roll for your quilt, you will need to have two of them or to supplement with yardage. A typical jelly roll precut has 40 strips and you will need 54. I supplemented my jelly roll with complementary fabric.
