Beginning Quilting Skills Level 2

- Quilt pattern (pdf) **Circle the Square** available at Quilting Daily at <https://www.quiltingdaily.com/product/circle-the-square-quilt-pattern-download/> Cost = \$7.99
- Fabrics as outlined in the Materials Section of the pattern.

Note: the pattern calls for 60 precut 10" squares, sometimes known as a layer cake. If you choose to make the throw /bed size quilt of 60 1/2" x 82" you will need to purchase 2 layer cake packs. One layer cake usually contains about 40-42 10-inch squares. OR you can do as I did and use yardage instead of the precut layer cake packs. One layer cake is usually equal to 2.75-3 yards. However, since you will want a variety of fabrics in your quilt, you will have to make a guess as to how much fabric to buy. Keep in mind that a quarter yard cut is 9" long and thus will not work for use in this pattern. The minimum fabric cut is 1/2 yard or 18 inches.

- Rotary cutter and ruler
- If you are bringing your own machine, please make sure you have a 1/4" foot sometimes referred to as a patchwork foot.
- Basic sewing supplies such as sewing machine needles, scissors, thread in a neutral color, seam ripper, some extra scraps for practice

If you are confident in your cutting skills, cutting out your fabric before class will help you get further along in constructing your quilt. It's not necessary to cut out your borders or binding before class.

You can choose to vary the size of the quilt from the instructions. You can make it larger or smaller. My sample is a 9-block quilt—3 rows of 3 squares.
