Sweet-heart Quilt Class Supply List

The class quilted sample is approximately 24 x 24.

The sample quilt was made using scraps from different shades of reproduction fabrics in burgundy, red, cream, and ivory colors.

Light fabrics: 1 yard total

Dark fabrics: 1 yard total

Batting: 26 x 26. Consider Batting bits from the OCS.

Backing: 28 x 28

*Important: If you are making a scrappy quilt: for the LIGHT fabric please insure you have enough fabric for (2) 7.5 inch square cuts, (4) 5 inch squares, (2) 4 inch squares, (2) 3.5 inch WOF strips, (2) 2 inch WOF strips, and (3) 1.25 inch WOF strips.

For the scrappy DARK fabric: (8) 1.25 WOF strips, and (3) WOF strips cut at your desired width for binding.

***These measurements above represent what is actually needed. I you wish to have a margin or more fabrics to choose from, please bring extra. Consider charm packs for or layer cakes for piecing or a fat quarter pack will give you plenty of fabric. Choose another combination of color to suit you desire such as blue and white, black and white, pink and red, etc.

Other Supplies:

Thread for piecing and quilting. I used Auriful 50 color 2312. I used 70/10 needles for piecing. A 1/4 inch foot with a guide is very helpful or a 1/4 inch foot.

I always use Quilter's Select rulers when cutting smaller pieces. I like the 1.5×12 inch ruler and any of the smaller square rulers 5 inch and under, especially the 2.5×2.5 . A chalk pencil to draw lines.

I used the Sweetheart Stencil from Laundry Baskets Quilts for the quilted hearts. An erasable Frixion pen.

Pins for piecing, small scissors, a seam ripper, and if you prefer to bring your own, a small iron, ironing mat, your machine with foot, and other supplies that you prefer.
