Fabric: Yardage amounts are listed on the pattern.

Notions:

- Lightweight fusible interfacing: four 19" squares. (Pellon 44F is perfect for this project.) You can also use 1-1/2" gridded interfacing if you like, but it's not necessary.

Basic Sewing Kit:

- Machine piecing thread in a neutral shade to match your fabrics.
- Fabric shears (a pair with thin blades like Karen Kay Buckley scissors is helpful)
- Thread snips or scissors
- Straight pins

Sewing Machine, etc.:

- Sewing machine in working order
- Machine needles
- ¼" patchwork foot
- Walking foot
- Zipper foot

Rotary Cutting Supplies:

- Rotary cutter with a fresh blade
- Acrylic ruler
- Rotary cutting mat

Pressing Supplies:

- iron
- 20" square pressing surface, or two layers of 100" cotton batting to protect your work surface. (I will have my favorite pressing boards available for sale.)
- Pressing cloth
- Spray bottle with water
- Wooly pressing bar for pressing seams open

Please cut your fabric squares prior to class. I found the Stripology ruler to be helpful for cutting the large number of background squares. The key is to stay organized and label your colors. I used a mini design board to keep everything in order.

Pillow Finishing Supplies:

- 26" square of fabric for back of pillow top
- 26" square of low loft cotton batting
- ¾ yard of backing fabric
- 1-1/2 yds. Shape Flex 101
- 26" or longer zipper
- Binding: ¼ yard

- 24" pillow form or supplies to make a custom pillow form

We likely won't get to the pillow finishing stage in class, but I will walk you through that process. You can also choose to do a wall hanging or table topper.
